



Dr. Allan Syril **Mulla** is the Director of Mergers, Research and Advocacy at Fair Competition Commission since 2009, where he has previously served as the Acting Director General for over one year. He is responsible for review of mergers and exemptions for agreements, competition and market research as well as conducting competition advocacy programs to the Government, business community and the academia. He is also a Lead consultant at the United Nations Conference for Trade and Development (UNCTAD). He has worked as an Institutional Development Specialist for the Government of Tanzania between 2006 and 2007. Other previous roles include consulting for the Economic and Social Research Foundation in Tanzania (ESRF), GIZ and the Overseas Development Institute (ODI).
