



Dr. Frederick Shadrack **RINGO** - is a Tanzanian lawyer, currently the Director General and the COMMISSIONER of the Fair Competition Commission since 2013. He has been an academic for 13 years at the University of Dar es Salaam. He later became the Principal Legal Counsel for the Privatization Commission for 3 years, responsible for all legal advice on major transactions including port, water, and telecommunication and banking privatization. He moved on to become the Chief Legal Counsel of the African Export Import Bank in Cairo, Egypt, for 5 years and was responsible for structured trade transactions including forfeiting, syndications, securitizations and project financing. In 2003, he returned back to Tanzania and started his own law firm – Ringo & Associates Advocates, which was a founder member firm of the Africa Legal Network of firms. It later changed its name of ADEPT Chambers Advocates. After 10 years of practice in commercial disputes resolution he was appointed to his current position. He is also a Chartered Arbitrator (UK) and a member of the Tanzania Institute of Arbitrators.
